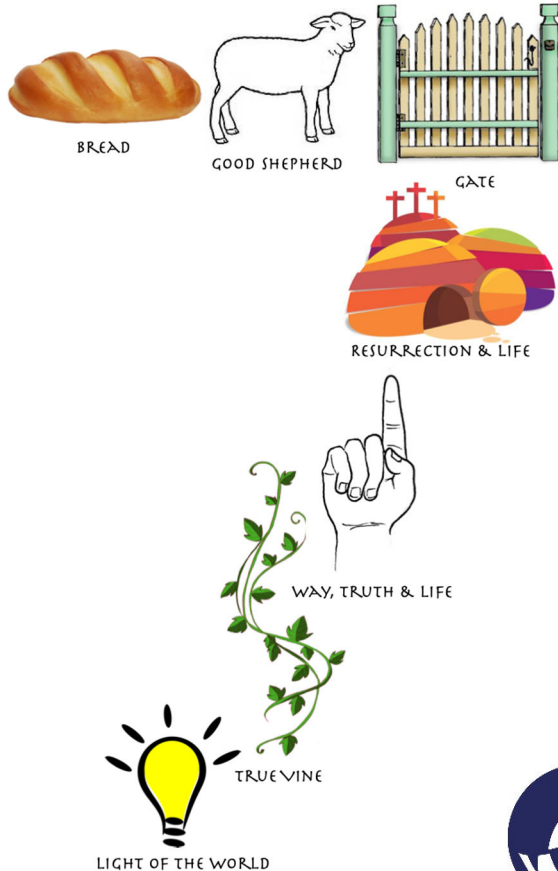

Local Believers and Missionaries

- for good collaboration between mission societies at work in Senegal

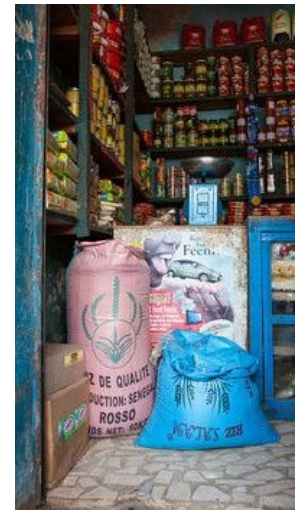

Life Jn 11:25**

Spiritual and religious authorities

Jesus demonstrated His power in all areas of life and death. Let’s pray for those in power in Senegal:

Pray for the national and local leaders of the Muslim communities,

- that God would reveal himself to them
- to use the authority and power given to them for building His Kingdom
- for dreams and visions of Jesus

Pray for believers and ministries that are in contact with political and religious leaders.

I am the True Vine Jn 15:1

Agriculture / rural communities

Pray for a movement of missionaries willing to live in these rural communities to share God's love there.

Pray for the planting season this year, that He would bring sufficient rain when needed for a good harvest.

Deforestation is a challenge as families cook over wood and make charcoal for extra income. Pray that people would learn to live sustainably in their changing environment.

Lord, You are the True Vine. Let people put their trust in your name and provision. May Your roots and fruit spread in communities around Senegal for Your renown.



I am the Good Shepherd Jn 10:11

Nomads and herders

Some people in Senegal still depend on cow, goat, and sheep herds and the nomadic lifestyle. Their herds are their wealth.

The nomadic lifestyle makes them hard to reach, but most have a radio or phone.

Pray

- that they would find the true Good Shepherd
- that Senegal's livestock herders would not turn to violence to protect their herds
- for an anointing on the digital ministries, SD cards, radio stations

I am the Gate/Door Jn 10:9

Youth

Most people in Senegal are under 25 years old. High unemployment, illiteracy, and poverty dim their prospects and steal their hope.

Pray for young people

- to find that Jesus is the Gate to life, freedom, satisfaction, and salvation
- to make wise decisions
- to see through the illusions of easy wealth overseas

I am the Light of the World

Jn 8:12

Towns and cities

Access to electricity, running water, and basic sanitation makes a huge difference in people's lives. It means that

- kids have time to do homework, and can study at night
- people can keep food in the fridge instead of going shopping every day
- water for cleaning and doing laundry and staying healthy is easy to get

Unfortunately, many people don't have it.

Pray

- for continued development of water, electricity and phone networks
- that people will learn to use these resources well
- for the new wind and solar farms being built
- for people to learn to use the internet to find accurate information, good jobs and services that will improve lives
- that as basic needs are met, people learn
